

# Series

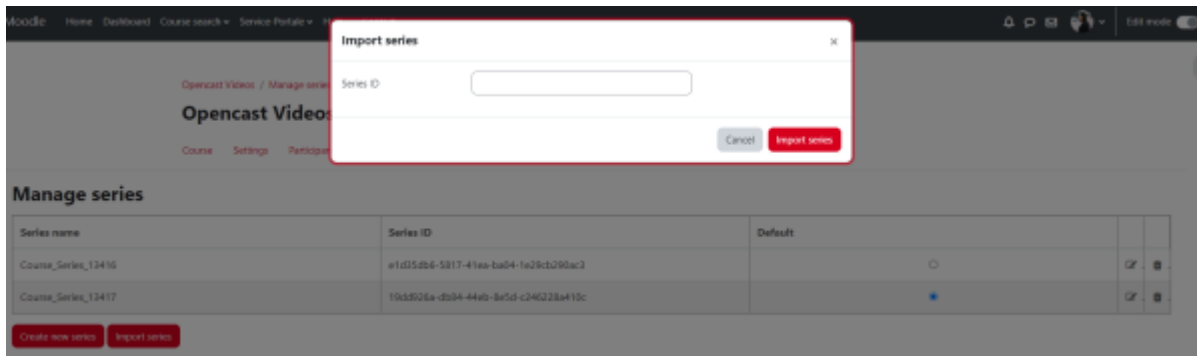
